For IRS assistance, please fill out a [Privacy Act Release](#) form and send it to my Rochester, Minnesota office. Please include copies of any important documentation or recent IRS notices that might help us to more accurately understand your problem.

### ***Frequently Asked Questions:***

#### **Can Congressman Walz's office find out when I will receive my tax refund?**

To check the status of your Federal tax refund from the Internal Revenue Service, visit the IRS website at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov) .

If status information is not available, or you did not receive your refund in the time listed on the IRS website, my office can contact the IRS on your behalf. Please fill out a [Privacy Act Release](#) form and send it to my Rochester office.

For information on your Minnesota state tax refund from the Minnesota Department of Revenue, visit [www.taxes.state.mn.us](http://www.taxes.state.mn.us) . Because this is a Minnesota state agency and not a federal agency, you will need to contact your state elected officials for additional assistance.

#### **How do I locate IRS forms and find e-filing information?**

**I am having a problem with the IRS that I have been unable to resolve on my own. Can Congressman Walz's office contact the IRS for me?**

If you are having a problem with the IRS and have been unable to resolve it on your own through normal channels, my office can contact the IRS on your behalf. My staff works with the Taxpayer Advocate Service, an IRS program that provides an independent system to assure that tax problems are promptly and fairly handled.
