

Walz to get input and involve southern Minnesotans in budget decision-making process □

Mankato, MN – Today, Congressman Tim Walz announced he is inviting southern Minnesotans to join him Tuesday January 29th for a town hall on the federal deficit in Albert Lea. The town hall will be interactive, offering attendees the ability to decide how to balance the budget and reduce the deficit.
